- To enhance the quality of teaching, research, counseling and service from faculty members, this Department Faculty Evaluation Implementation Guidelines ("The Guidelines") was defined by National Sun Yat-sen University Department of Marine Biotechnology and Resources ("The Department") in accordance with the University's Faculty Evaluation Guidelines and Faculty Evaluation Implementation Guidelines.
- The Guidelines include the evaluation areas, methods, standards and procedure. The evaluation shall be conducted in accordance with the University's Faculty Evaluation Guidelines and Faculty Evaluation Implementation Guidelines unless otherwise specified in the Guidelines.

The evaluation standard is as stated in the Faculty Evaluation Table and Faculty Evaluation Indicators of this College. For faculty members above the grade of assistant professor, "teaching", "research" and "counseling and service" account for 40%, 40% and 20% of the evaluation respectively. Faculty members holding an "IC Card for Severe Illness" or "Handbook for the Handicapped" may adjust the percentage of each area within the following range: between 40 ~ 60% for teaching, between 30 ~ 50% for research, and between 10 ~ 30% for counseling and service.

4. The Guidelines were approved by the Department Affairs Council, College Faculty Evaluation Committee, University Faculty Evaluation Committee and University Council prior to implementation. Modifications shall follow the same procedure.
